- 4. Competition is open to all children aged 7-14 who live in North West Leicestershire.
- 5. Entries must include the child's name, age, and either their home or school postcode.
- 6. In entering the competition, parents and guardians give permission to Hospice Hope and the judges panel to view the child's name, school and/or home postcode.
- 7. The charity and judges will not hold other information, and all personal data, both digital and postal for those not shortlisted, will be destroyed after the competition winners have been announced.
- 8. It is advised that any postal submission sent which the child would like to retain, be a copy, with the original kept by the author.
- 9. Competition winners will be named and shared on the charity's website and social media pages. Winners will also be announced in local press and magazines both printed and online. Hospice Hope would like to take photographs of the winners to use in all publicity and will approach parents and guardians with the appropriate consent forms. No images will be shared without consent.
